What is Camino?

The **Camino** de Santiago, or the Way of Saint James, was an epic Catholic pilgrimage to the Spanish city of Santiago de Compostela. Now more of a leisure and fun walk, "**Walking the Camino**" is a chance to intentionally slow down and move at a human pace, to join a history that's so much bigger than any of us individually.

The complete CAMINO is a long 800km trail that has inspired many artists, writers and filmmakers to document their profound journey such as Paulo Coelho in his bestsellter **The Pilgrimage** and 2010's Hollywood movie **The Way** starring Martin Sheen.


Classic Camino (The French Way) Last 100KM | 7 DAYS

You will be walking the last 100kms (most popular trail) of the famous Camino Francés from Sarria to Santiago de Compostela over 7 days, across the green rolling landscapes of rural Galicia.

This is the most popular <u>Camino de Santiago</u> trip and perfectly captures the essence of the Camino: Meet fellow pilgrims, discover local traditions, and enjoy the unique atmosphere of it all, rewarding yourself with good food after your day's walk.

OUTLINE ITINERARY: THE CLASSIC CAMINO (FRENCH WAY)

- DAY 1: ARRIVAL IN SARRIA FROM SANTIAGO DE
- COMPOSTELA AIRPORT
- DAY 2: WALK 22 KM TO PORTO MARIN
- DAY 3: WALK 24 KM TO PALAS DE REI
- DAY 4: WALK DOWNHILL VIA CASANOVA & LEBOREIRO TO ARZUA- 29 KM
- DAY 5: WALK 18 KM TO RUA-O PINO
- DAY 6: RUA-O PINO TO SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA 21 KM
- DAY 7: AFTER BREAKFAST, DEPARTURE FROM SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELLA.
